Protecting yourself and others from scams online'. The day will allow the children to share their experiences and ideas on how to tackle the problem at an age appropriate level

with them joining in a range of activities during this important day. As part of the day, all of the junior children will watch a 50 minute LIVE interactive fun and age appropriate virtual LIVE lesson focused on cyber security.

Please note that we close for half term on Friday, 14th February (normal end of day timings) and return to school after the half term holiday on Monday, 24th February.


