



SAFER INTERNET DAY- 11th February



Safer Internet Day is the UK's biggest celebration of online safety. Each year the day covers an online issue or theme that speaks about the things young people are seeing and experiencing online. This year, Safer Internet Day 2025 takes place on the 11th of February 2025, with celebrations and learning based around the theme '**Too good to be true? Protecting yourself and others from scams online**'. The day will allow the children to share their experiences and ideas on how to tackle the problem at an age appropriate level with them joining in a range of activities during this important day. As part of the day, all of the junior children will watch a 50 minute LIVE interactive fun and age appropriate virtual LIVE lesson focused on cyber security.

Cosying up with a book is something we all love to do, so on the day the children will be invited to either:

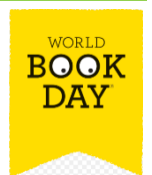
- **Wear pyjamas or something cosy**, e.g. dressing gown, cosy jumper, fluffy socks or cosy clothes

YEAR 6 SATs (STATUTORY ASSESSMENTS)



Between **Monday, 12th May 2025 and Friday, 16th May 2025**, our Year 6 children will sit the National Curriculum Statutory Assessment Tests (SATs). We are legally obliged to test the children **ONLY** on the dates provided by the DfE. Please ensure that your child is in school during this period, as there will be no opportunity for the children to re-sit the tests on an alternative date.
