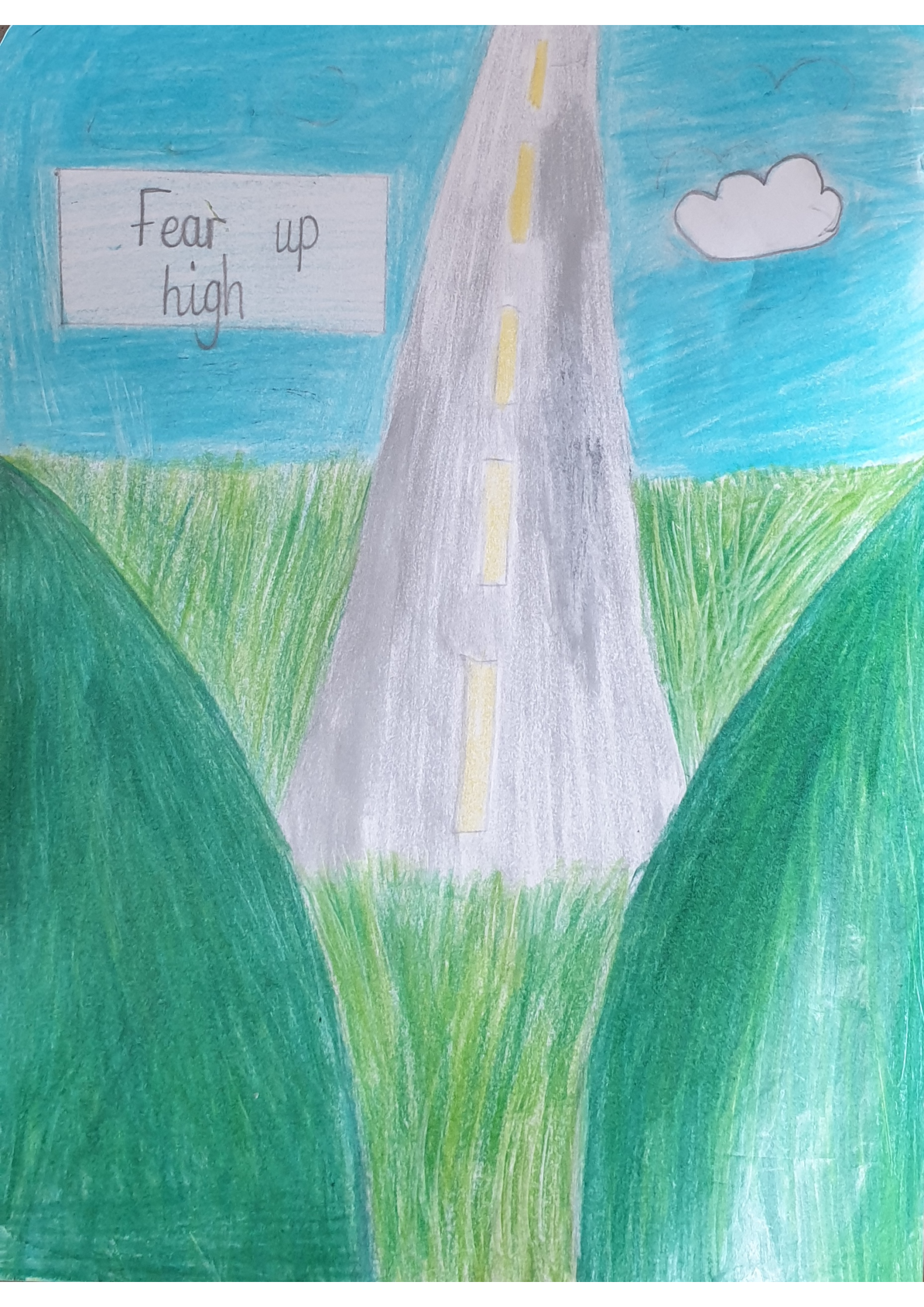


Fear up
